Augean Robotics, Inc. is looking for a bilingual (Spanish/English) field technician, who can operate our robots (see them at www.agrbt.com) in the field and communicate with the largely Spanish-speaking workforce that utilizes our robots.

We are fast-growing, venture-backed company that provides robot-enabled solutions to the significant challenges faced by today's growers—chief among them rising wages and a shrinking workforce. Today, we are pilot testing our launch product, Burro, with large growers of crops like table grapes, blueberries, and other hand-harvested crops. Growers of these crops are using Burros as virtual conveyor belts, automating in-field transport and enabling workers to focus on high-value tasks.

The ideal candidate is entrepreneurial-minded, and interested in a part time/temporary role that if successful can evolve into a full-time position.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Manage/operate Burro robots in the field
- Communicate with teams of workers using Burros, to teach them how to use robots, and to understand issues they have that Augean Robotics should address
- Consistently communicate with foremen on sites about farm activities, challenges, and innovative ways Burros might be further utilized
